The approval for additional course(s) / increase in intake / variation in intake is valid for two years from the date of issue of this letter till getting affiliation with respective university and fulfilling all the requirements of admission.

The institution shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form, in the light of the order of Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition No. 658/1998. In case of failure to prevent the occurrence of ragging by the institutions, the Council shall take appropriate action including withdrawal of approval.

The approval is being granted based on the projections shown in the Detailed Project Report regarding additional courses, faculty and other facilities for the proposed intake. It may be noted that all facilities including additional courses and appointment of faculty should be made available before the commencement of the next academic session. An on-site inspection would be carried out to verify facilities and if the institute is found deficient in fulfillment of standards of AICTE, appropriate action would be initiated by the Council.

It is noted that other terms & conditions in the earlier letter will remain unchanged.

The approval is granted based on the appraisal of the information submitted by the institution on infrastructural facilities for the proposed course(s). Therefore, the approval is subject to the verification of the facilities by the institution through an Expert Committee Visit. In case the claims made by the institution is found to be false, the approval granted shall be liable to be withdrawn.

The proposal for increase in intake/ additional course(s) has been processed in accordance with MHRD letter no. 1-4/2009-TS-II dated 12.08.2009.
